VEHICLES & BICYCLES

The speed limit within all areas of the park is 10km/h, this includes bicycles etc. Bicycles are only allowed during daylight hours for safety reasons. Please stay on the tracks as much as possible. Sites accommodate one car, for additional and day-visitor vehicles please seek approval at reception. Servicing of motor vehicles is not to be conducted in the park.

NOISE

We particularly ask that noise be kept to a minimum at all times, especially after 10pm.

Our customers come to Wooyung Beach to enjoy the peace and quiet of bush camping. Excessive noise or abusive language will NOT be tolerated and can result in being asked to leave the park immediately with no refund.

Chainsaws and Generators are not permitted to be used by anyone outside management at any time in the Park. Quiet time is between 10pm – 9am.

FIRES & FIREWOOD

Open fires are allowed off the ground only.

We provide some fire boxes on a rack and some concrete fireplaces. We sell bags of firewood and you are welcome to bring your own. Please do not destroy our vegetation for this purpose and please do not burn rubbish! At times of total fire bans fires are not permitted. Please stay out of forested areas on the park at all times. Please do not collect wood from the littoral rainforest across the road. It is protected and can incur a heavy fine.

RUBBISH

Please recycle. Separate domestic rubbish from glass/cans/paper etc. using the bins provided. Please assist by having domestic rubbish wrapped and placed in our Blue lid wheelie bins and Recyclables into the Yellow lid wheelie bins.

Please don't burn any rubbish-Please do not dispose of bulk rubbish (eg your broken camp chair) in the park, please take any large broken items home with you.

WATER & AMENITIES

We collect and use rainwater here at Wooyung, please be mindful when using this limited resource, we also have some borewater taps throughout the park, these are great for rinsing sand off, please refer to the map for tap locations. You can fill containers with rainwater at the amenities block for use at your site.

Parents, please accompany children under 10 years to the toilet block.

Laundry and wash-up sinks are located at the amenities block, machines take \$1 coins.

We are on a Septic System here at Wooyung, please do not flush anything apart from toilet paper provided. All sanitary items, wipes, nappies etc must be wrapped and placed in the bins provided, foreign objects can damage septic pumps, your attention to this required as it can affect the whole park.

A purpose built Ambulant bathroom is now available. Please see Reception to request a key. Deposit required.

POWER

An approved circuit breaker and residual current device are necessary to provide power to powered sites. As our visitors come with the purpose to enjoy the peace and silence of the park, we do not allow generators to be operated. Please do not overload the circuit as it may trip the power and you neighbours power too.

SITES

Please keep your possessions and vehicles within the sites you have been allocated and respect walkways and roads. Keep your site tidy and do not dig trenches on or around your site. Please leave at least 2.5m between neighbouring setups. Bush turkeys will rip up and take anything left in bags outside your tent – so keep things in containers or inside.

WILDLIFE & PETS

The park is full of wildlife and they live here, please be mindful this is their habitat. Please do not chase or catch any animals.

Dogs are permitted, (strictly NO Cats) subject to management approval when booking in and proper supervision at all times.

All pets must be declared prior to entering the park and they must be kept quiet and on a leash at all times within the park. Do not leave your pet unattended and it is the pet owners responsibility to clean up after them immediately.

Under no circumstances are pets allowed to enter the park's accommodation or amenities block.
